

Shift Linkage Adjustment






- 1. Apply the parking brake.
- 2. Remove the shifter closeout boot.
- 3. Place the shifter into NEUTRAL.
- 4. Press down to engage the shifter neutral lock pin.



- 5. Loosen the transmission shift rod clamp bolt.
- 6. Loosen the shifter mounting bolts.
- 7. Check that the shifter locator (on the underside of the shift control) is installed into the shifter bracket on the side of the driveline support assembly.

- 8. Tighten the shifter mounting bolts to 30 N·m (22 lb ft).
- 9. Tighten the transmission shift rod clamp bolt to 30 N·m (22 lb ft).



- 10. Lift to release the shifter neutral lock pin.
- 11. Install the shifter closeout boot.
- 12. Release the parking brake.
